Halton Child Development Centre (CDC)

Halton CDC is a base for a number of health services.

These health services provide assessment, advice, treatment and ongoing care for children and young people aged 0-19 who may need extra support.

Each health service has their own leaflet to explain what they do. These leaflets can be found on the Trust website:

Who can make a referral to CDC services?

Referrals are accepted from:

- Health care professionals
- Education staff
- Local Authority.

Can I self-refer my child?

You can self-refer your child to Speech and Language Therapy – you will need to email Chatterbugs to request a referral form:

haltonslt@chatter-bug.com

What happens after referral?

Each service will review the information on your child's referral form.

If your child only requires one service, such as physiotherapy, occupational therapy, you will be sent a letter from that service.





This letter will confirm the contact details of the service that has accepted your child's referral. It will also give you the chance to contact the service to agree an appointment time.

What if my child requires extra support?

Some children may also need support form a Care Co-ordinator (a health professional) to support them through the process.

If your child needs a Care Co-ordinator we will let you know their contact details once your child's referral has been accepted.

What happens if the referral is not accepted?

We will notify the referrer by letter.

Please see the individual service leaflets for more information about why some children may not be accepted.
