# Instructions for patients who have received Flumazenil

Flumazenil is a drug that temporarily reverses the effects of sedation with midazolam.

- The effects of flumazenil will wear off before the effects of the midazolam
- Despite feeling alert when leaving the surgery, the effects of the sedative drug can reoccur, affecting memory and judgement
- You may feel increasingly sedated and sleepy a few hours after leaving the surgery
- Please follow the instructions provided in your aftercare information leaflet
- The post-operative instructions must be followed even if you feel you have recovered fully and no longer feel drowsy.
